"How did they all fit?"

This is the question we keep getting asked over and over again as we share with people that 28 girls stayed in one beach house and 11 guys stayed in our house this past weekend for spring retreat.

The girls spent the weekend talking about our identity in Christ and how the Lord desires to satisfy our deepest longings and needs but we tend to look to the things of this world instead of to Christ. We saw several students who do not currently have a relationship with Christ move many steps closer to making this important decision as they opened up and had significant spiritual conversations where they confessed that the Lord was working on their hearts and they were very close to surrendering their lives to him. One girl even shared that Emerson played a major role in her opening up and sharing a dark secret in her life that she had never told anyone. Praise the Lord for using our precious baby to bring a girl closer to knowing Him as her Savior.

Did we lose sleep? Yes. Did we need a few more bathrooms for the women? Yes. Did we have to give directions more times than we can count on two hands as they continually got lost? Yes. But the Lord used every part of the weekend - the car accident, students getting pulled over by police, almost running out of food, students showing up unexpected at the last possible minute to bring glory to His name and to move in these students' hearts.
