other students stayed for the remainder
of the summer, including two of our
students from ENC and one former
student from Kentucky. Overall, the
Gospel was shared 233 times and one

person made a decision for Christ! This is a huge deal in an area of the world so steeped in Islam where making a decision to follow Christ may mean being shunned by your family and friends. Also, one of our students is seriously considering doing a one year mission trip back to Senegal after he graduates.

SOUTHEAST ASIA

Britt and Kim (names changed for protection) are two twin girls who were students of ours when we were serving in Kentucky. We met them when they were freshmen, April was able to disciple one of them, and we saw the Lord use them greatly in college. They graduated, attended graduate school where they continued to make a difference, got "real world" jobs, but have recently decided to do a sports internship (mission project) in Southeast Asia teaching English classes in high school and leading sports clinics on college campuses through a partnership with their church in the US.

They just recently had their first Gospel conversation with one of the teachers. She was asking them a lot of questions and wants to read Scripture with them next week!
