We love to give you updates on students that we have worked with in the past. This is an update from Ty, a guy from Morehead State in KY, whom Ed discipled for almost 3 years.

"If you would have told me that after graduating from Morehead State I would be a missionary in the Middle East. I would have laughed at you. I'm so thankful for the time Ed spent discipling me in my walk with Jesus and equipping me to lead and teach other students how to walk with Jesus. Looking back, I now see how God used this time of growth and development to prepare me to be sent from my campus to reach the world with the gospel of Jesus. All the spiritual conversations I had with my peers, learning how to share my faith with strangers on campus, all the hard conversations about fleeing temptation and sin with Ed, and the late hours spent loving on freshmen and praying for them to have a heart for their campus and the world - ALL WORTH IT!!

The best legacies left are the ones where you are forgotten and Jesus is remembered and glorified. I've been off campus for a little over a year now and I look back at these guys I invested into and see them running a ministry that didn't exist when I started college. They tell me how their friends came to faith through equipping we did together. God

had a bigger plan for Morehead than I could ever imagine. Now students are being sent on summer missions. It feels humbling having God use me to pave a way for other students to serve in places where the Gospel has not gone.

Now serving in the middle East with Cru, I see exactly why God had me involved with Cru in college. The same things we did at Morehead to start a movement we are doing here. The only difference is we adapt it for the culture we are living in. I've had the privilege of seeing two guys I've been working with come to know Jesus - both from Muslim backgrounds. This is unheard of in this part of the world. Soil is tough but Jesus is still good and always faithful. God is moving here. We have had teams in here for 6 years now and we have only seen a handful of people from a Muslim background come to know Jesus. This is truly a celebration of victory over Satan and the lies of Islam. What a privilege it is to see Arabic students come to know the abundant life Jesus desires for us to live."

Praise the Lord for students like Ty, who are serving the Lord overseas sharing the love of Christ with students who have never heard the name of Jesus or of the amazing gift of forgiveness and eternal life that He offers!! Thank you for being a vital part of this!!
