On Your Mark, Get Set, Go!

Since this is our first fall in Eastern NC, we wanted to give you an idea of the campuses we work with and the amazing stuff the Lord is doing at them!

UNC Pembroke - We, along with our 4 student leaders, had a survey table, gave out free stuff, and collected 175+ surveys. They also held a prayer walk, a movie night social, and two Bible studies have begun. At their first weekly meeting, they had 38 students - an increase from last year!!

Impact at NC Central Univ. - Our 6 leaders with this ministry for African American students collected 200+ surveys as they handed out freshmen survival kits and 30 students showed up to their info meeting. We are praying they will have 40+ students as their Bible study kicks off next week.

Wake Tech - We hosted a survey table, gave out cookies and free stuff, and collected 130+ surveys. We also held a pizza party/info meeting and 30 students came! Last year, 10 students were coming to Bible study, so this year we are praying for 20+. We have also seen 1 student accept Christ so far!

UNC Pembroke Athletes in Action - Our student leaders are setting up meetings with athletic teams to promote Bible study and collect surveys which will hopefully lead into spiritual conversations with other athletes.

Central Carolina Community College - We held a survey table to try to kick off a ministry at this school and received 160+ contact cards. A Bible study should be starting in the next few weeks!

Impact at UNC Pembroke - We, along with our 4 student leaders, hosted a survey table where 170+ contacts were collected. They began Bible study this week and 27 students came.

Campbell University - While we had a small Bible study on this campus last year, Cru, or any outside organization, isn't allowed on campus. But, because churches are, we have started a partnership with our church to reach the campus for Christ! We hosted a table where we gave out cookies, drinks, and had a raffle for gift cards in exchange for getting students to fill out surveys. 225+ surveys were filled out. Then, we had a pizza party/info meeting and 40+ students showed up! At our first Bible study, 18 students attended. Praise the Lord for this church partnership which will allow us to reach the campus!

St. Andrews - School hasn't begun yet so next week, along with our 2 student leaders, we will have a table where we hand out free stuff to get contact cards and get Bible study kicked off!

Bladen Community College - This ministry, which is completely run by a faculty volunteer, is having a table this

week where they will collect contacts and promote Bible study. The faculty Bible study, of which 25% of the campus faculty attends, should also begin soon!

Prayer Requests:

- Praise - 1 student has already accepted Christ!
- Pray for our Fall Retreat Oct 5-7 that students would sign up and we would see 80 students attend!
- Pray that the Lord would open the hearts and minds of students as we followup with all the surveys we collected. Pray that we will see many, many students come to know Him and get plugged in!
- Pray that the Lord would move in a mighty way on all our campuses!
