Let the Fall Begin!

While numbers aren't everything, we pray that these give you a better idea of what we are doing and how thankful we are for how the Lord is already moving!

UNC Pembroke - We, along with 2 student leaders, had a survey table, gave out free stuff, and collected 200+ surveys. They have three Bible studies: male, female, and freshmen. They had over 16 girls at their first women's Bible study - this is a great start!

Impact at UNCP - We, along with 4 student leaders, hosted a survey table where 180+ contacts were collected. They have three Bible studies: male, female, and freshmen. They are in the process of following up the surveys from the table and they have already seen one girl place her faith in Christ!!

Nations at UNCP - This semester, we, along with a Native American student and volunteer, are launching a Bible study reaching out to Native American students (Pembroke has one of the largest tribes on the East Coast). At our survey table, we collected 50 surveys of students that are interested in hearing more about God and Nations!

Wake Tech Main - We, along with our 3 student leaders, hosted a survey table, and collected 190 surveys. We have one Bible study and a weekly prayer time. Last year, we didn't have any student leaders at the beginning of the

year, and now we have three!

Wake Tech North - With our student leader and two faculty volunteers, will be having a survey table next week to get contacts. There were 25-30 students coming to Bible study last year and 5 students trusted Christ so, this year, we are praying for even more.

Central Carolina Community - There are two Bible studies going on and they are planning a survey table to kick off the new school year.

Campbell University - In partnership with our church and a student leader, we helped with freshmen move-in, had a table where we gave out cookies and drinks, and collected 110 surveys. We plan to have a weekly Bible study and a community group with the church. Praise the Lord for this church partnership which is allowing us to reach the campus!

Fayetteville State - As there are NO ministries on this campus, we are praying to launch a Bible study this fall. We had a survey table and collected 215 surveys!!

Bladen Community - We have one faculty volunteer who organizes and brings in local pastors to lead a Bible study for students. They also have a Bible study for faculty members and last year, they had 20 faculty attending!

We had a survey table and saw a lot of good response. We are praying the Lord raises up committed students!

- Praise we are launching at two new places this fall (UNCP Nations and Fayetteville State).
- Pray for our Fall Retreat Sept. 27-29 that students would sign up and we would see 55 students from ENC attend!
