-Sydney, a student on our project who just accepted Christ two months ago, was so scared all summer to share her faith with others. When she finally did share the last week of project, she got to see Allyssa from LaGuardia College place her faith in Jesus!

-Joe, a student at City College, hung around with our students throughout the whole summer. Among lots of conversations, he heard the Gospel three different times from three different sets of our students. The last week we were here, and the third time he heard, he placed his faith in Jesus!
